## PARADE RULES

1. PARADE ASSEMBLY TIME: 9 a.m., NON-HORSE JUDGING TIME: 9 a.m. sharp., HORSE JUDGING: 9 a.m. sharp, PARADE START TIME: 11 a.m. sharp.
2. The Parade Committee will be in complete charge and will reserve the right to dismiss any entry that hurts the parade in word or deed, or in any way misrepresents the size, number, etc. of his entry. We also reserve the right to cancel any class in which the entries are not of sufficient number.
3. Horses will be judged over by the Police Department.
4. Traditional: A continuously moving parade from beginning to end. All entries will maintain forward motion at all times; there will be no stopping along the route.
5. Fifteen (15) feet spacing is required between all units. Improper spacing may disqualify you from competition.
6. Floats or units, which use sound amplifying systems, shall maintain a sound volume, which will not interfere with units in front or behind them. The use of sound systems must be noted on the entry blank. If not noted, entry may be disqualified! **NO HORNS, OR BURNING RUBBER ON TIRES!**
7. Marching units and floats will assemble at 9 a.m. at the Community Center. All entries **MUST** be in their proper places in the line of march by 9 a.m. All parade entries will be pre-judged after lineup **BEFORE THE PARADE STARTS**. Final judging will be done during the parade.
8. All parade units must complete the entries parade route. Those not doing so will be disqualified unless excused by the parade chairman.
9. The possession or use of alcohol or controlled substances by parade participants either in the staging area or along the parade route is forbidden. **NOTHING** can be thrown from floats, vehicles, or animals along the parade route. **THIS INCLUDES CANDY!**
10. Participants must at all times maintain control of vehicles and/or animals. **NO ONE UNDER SIX (6) MAY BE IN CONTROL OF THESE WITHOUT AN ADULT PRESENT.** Persons and/or animals riding on a float or in a car **MUST** be secured for safety. The primary responsibility of all parade participants and parade officials is the safety of all riders, children and spectators.
11. Judging will begin at 9 a.m. **ANY ENTRY NOT IN PLACE BY 9:45 a.m. WILL NOT BE JUDGED.** All identification numbers must be worn or placed on **LEFT FRONT** of entry in view of the judges.
12. All decisions of the judges will be final. Presentation of the awards will be at 1:30 p.m. at the buckle booth in the Recreation Grove. Score sheets will be sent to contestants who submit a self-addressed envelope.
13. Pacific Coast judges and Committee Rules will apply. A CSHA Judge will judge horse entries.
14. Entries close at Midnight, June 29, 2007.
15. A separate entry blank must be completed for each entry in the parade.
16. *Your signature on the enclosed application form certifies that you have read and will abide by the rules as outlined.*
17. The Parade Committee will open a new category if two or more entries request by the entry deadline.
18. If you or part of your group need to be with another group, **YOU MUST SPECIFY THIS ON YOUR ENTRY FORM**

*Any questions regarding horse and pony entries may be answered by reviewing CSHA Rules and Regulations.*
